Symposium on "Advanced Educational Technologies" will be held in the frame of the 32nd International Conference on Software, Telecommunications and Computer Networks (SoftCOM 2024), which is co-organized by the University of Split, FESB and Croatian Communications and Information Society (CCIS), and technically co-sponsored by the IEEE Communications Society (ComSoc), on September 26-28, 2024 in Split-Bol (island of Brač), Croatia.
